When the Surgery is Closed

If you become unwell when the surgery is closed please ring 111 and they will be able to advise you. This service is manned 24 hours per day, 7 days a week.

Carers

Do you look after someone who couldn't manage without your help? Please let us know so we can support you and put you in touch with Carers Support Wiltshire, who are a local charity.

Shingles

We offer Shingles vaccinations to the eligible cohort of patients between 70 and 80. Please contact the surgery to check if you are eligible.

Pneumococcal Vaccine

We would like to vaccinate patients over the age of 65 who are eligible for the pneumococcal vaccine. Please contact us to see if you are eligible and the necessary appointment can be booked in with either Ali or Elly.

We would like to reassure you all that the surgery is very much open, we are seeing those who need face to face appointments and are here to look after you.

NHS Health Checks

If you are aged between 40 and 74 and your age ends with a 0 or 5 you are eligible for a NHS Health check. If you would like this check, please call the surgery and book with a practice nurse. Ali or Elly will be very pleased to see you.

MenACWY

If you are aged between 18 and 25 you could be eligible for a MenACWY vaccine. Please call the surgery to book your appointment with one of our nurses.

Flu Vaccines

Flu vaccines will be offered to all clinically vulnerable patients as in previous years. They will also be offered to those over the age of 50, as last season. Child Flu vaccines, please contact us to book your 2 and 3 year olds in, or if your child has missed the school programme. Please keep an eye on our website and Facebook page for the most up to date information.

Covid-19 Booster Vaccines

These booster vaccines will be offered to all high risk patients, once it has been clarified by the Government. Our website will contain the most up to date information about these boosters and we will contact people when they are eligible.

We have also run our first Covid Booster clinic at Ramsbury surgery. Our over 80 patients received their booster and most also received their flu vaccines. The next two clinics are arranged for 3rd and 17th November for anyone that received their second dose before 17th May 2021.
